While we are addressing national channels, somewhere we need to have a repository for all interoperability information that pertains to the channels like TN uses 154.755/156.015 & 460/465.400 plus others we use. And I am sure there are local governments that have their own interoperability systems too that we need a place to find the info.

Also, on the 800 MHz channels, 821 – 823 – are those valid channels? Our radio software will not allow us to program these as simplex channels. Only the high side.
That might need clarification.
