NPSTC Draft 900 MHz Alerting Petition for Rulemaking

- 901-902, 930-931-940-941 MHz commercial spectrum auctioned in 1993 for “narrowband PCS” known as two-way paging in the industry
- Spectrum is currently licensed but has low usage
- On December 12, 2006, FCC granted the City of Richmond a waiver to use one channel at 23 sites.
- Draft Petition for Rulemaking requests that the FCC conduct an audit of this 900 MHz 2-way paging band and make available a portion of the band for public safety use.
- Discussion: defining the portion requested.
 - Need flexibility for alerting on a national, regional or local basis
