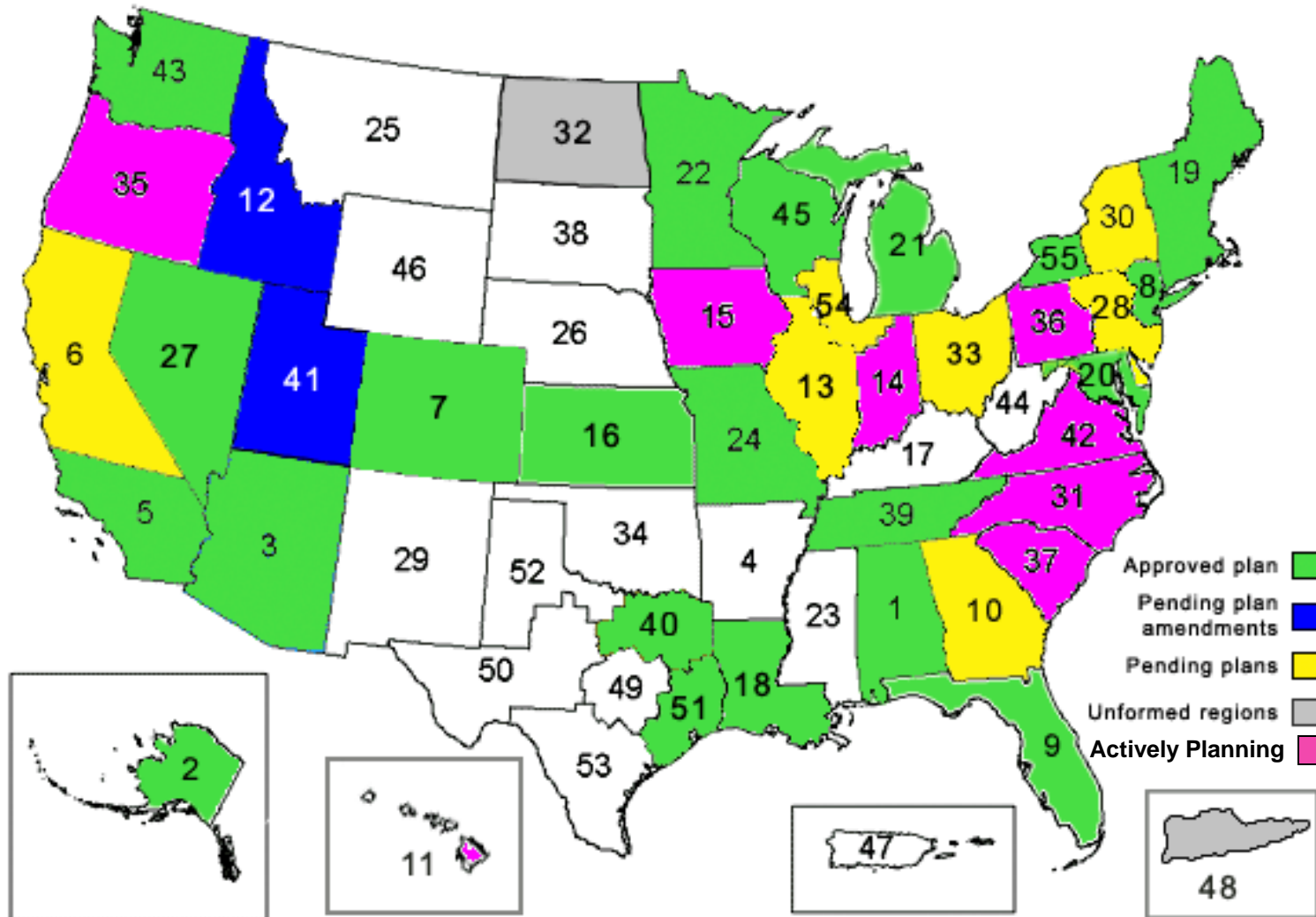

Regional Planning



- Eight 700 MHz Regional Plans Approved
 - Florida (Region 9) 4/20/2009
 - Kansas (Region 16) 4/21/2009
 - Louisiana (Region 18) 4/21/2009
 - New England (Region 19) 4/21/2009
 - New York City/N. NJ (Region 8) 5/4/2009
 - Nevada (Region 27) 6/2/2009
 - Western New York State (Region 55) 6/2/2009
 - Dallas (Region 40) 6/3/2009
- Twelve 700 MHz Regional Plans put on Public Notice
 - Three Public Notice period concluded
 - Five will conclude in June
- Thirty-six 800 MHz Regional Plans Filed
- 140 Applications filed for Nextel-vacated spectrum
 - 120 were granted
 - 9 remain pending
 - No additional frequencies yet released

DTV Transition



- DTV Transition deadline extended from February 17 to June 12, 2009
- FCC extended license terms of 700 MHz licenses for 116 days
 - State licensees given an additional 116 days to meet 5 year and 10 year substantial service deadlines
- Region 24 (Missouri) filed a Petition for Rulemaking asking that the spectrum efficiency and state license construction deadlines be extended to 2014 and 2019 to match the actual DTV transition deadline
 - Not yet placed on Public Notice
