NIIX Services

- Centralized access to peer-supplied documents, including various plans, agreements, governance, policy, legislation, SOPs, funding and other useful documents
- Ability for members to submit documents to a national library for sharing with peers
- Security and authentication ensures that only members with appropriate authorization have access to sensitive planning documents






NIIX Community Services



The Main page allows you to access documents and members on the national level Just check a radio button and click a state. You can also see all documents listed by category in the tree on the left hand side of the page.




Accessing Documents
